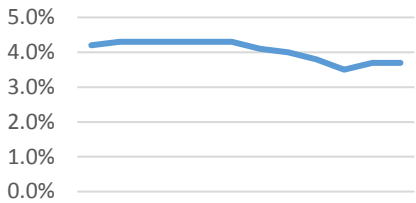

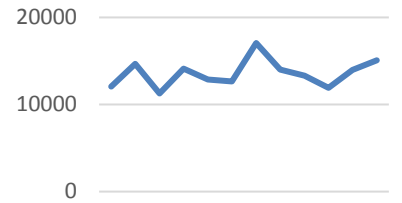

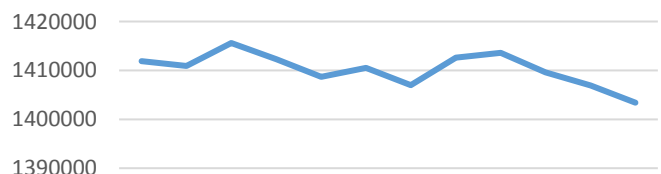

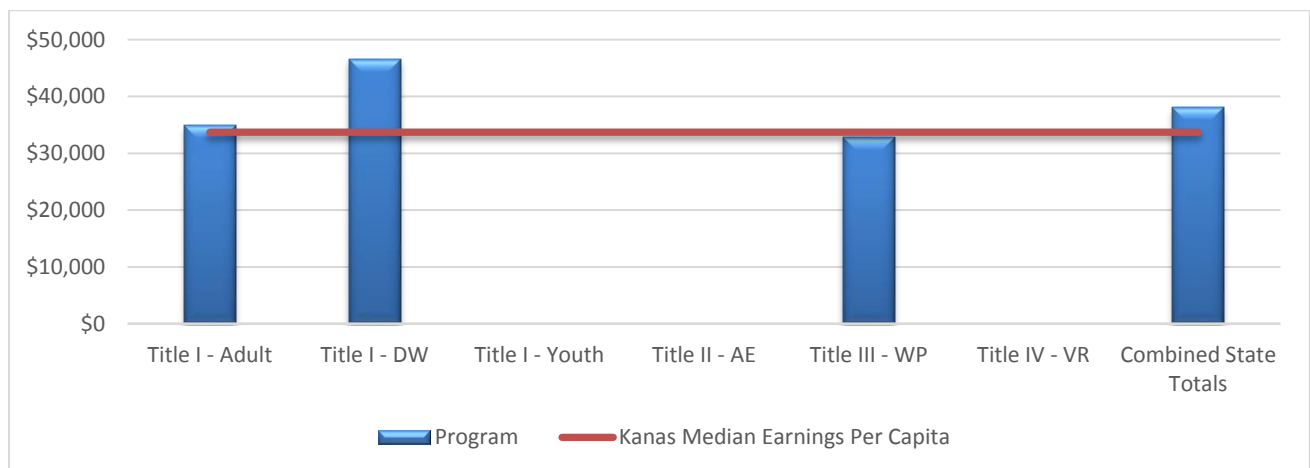

The following Q4 data is submitted as per the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Combined State Plan for Kansas.

**1. Educational Functioning Level gain: 56%**

Kansas adult education providers utilize the TABE assessment which determines the initial learning level for each student. An Educational Functioning Level (EFL) gain is a documented gain based on the initial assessment. The reported percentage represents the number of students who completed the level of instruction for which they were enrolled. (State target = 57.55%)

**2. Credentials Achieved: 312**

Students who achieved an industry-recognized credential.

**3. High School Diplomas Achieved: 932**

Kansas administers the GED test, and 87% of those attempting the test achieved their GED. (State target = 70%)

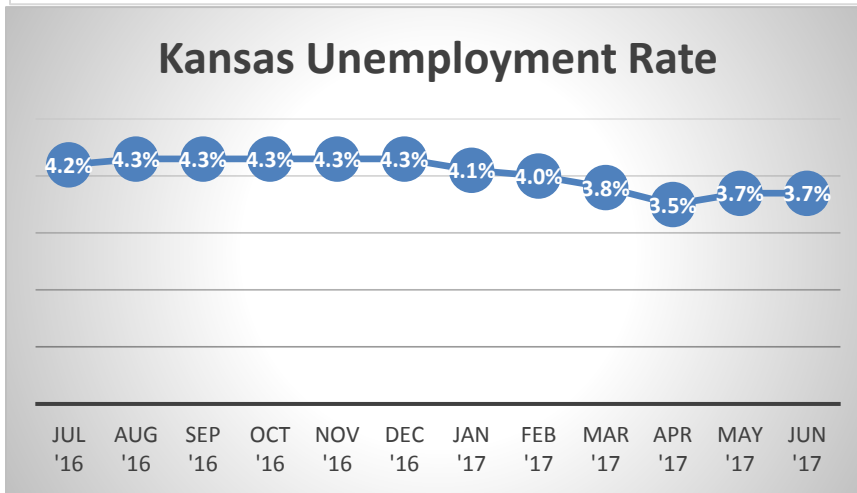
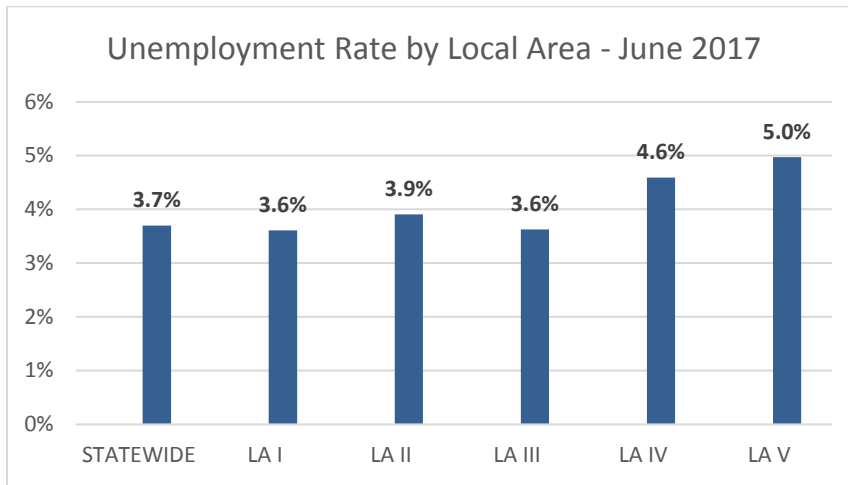

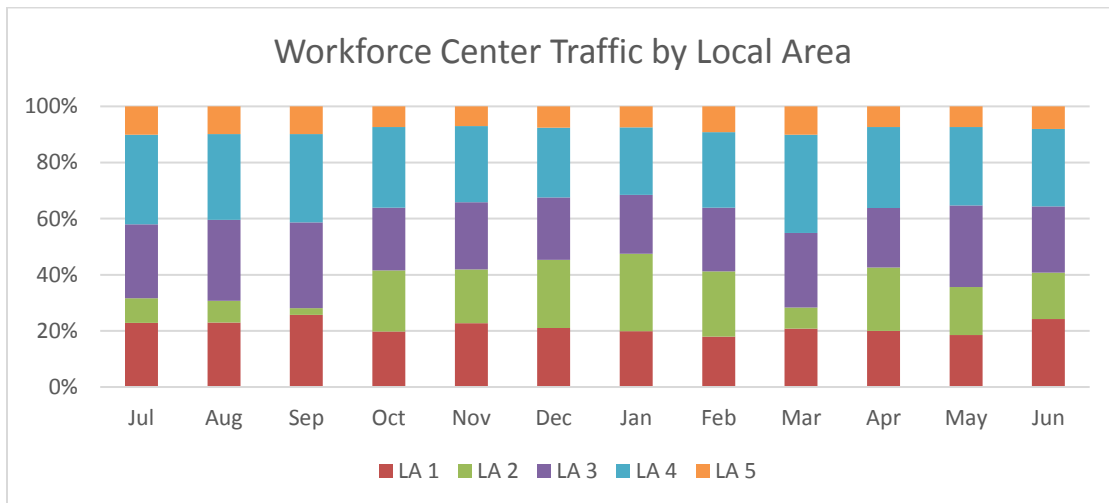
