

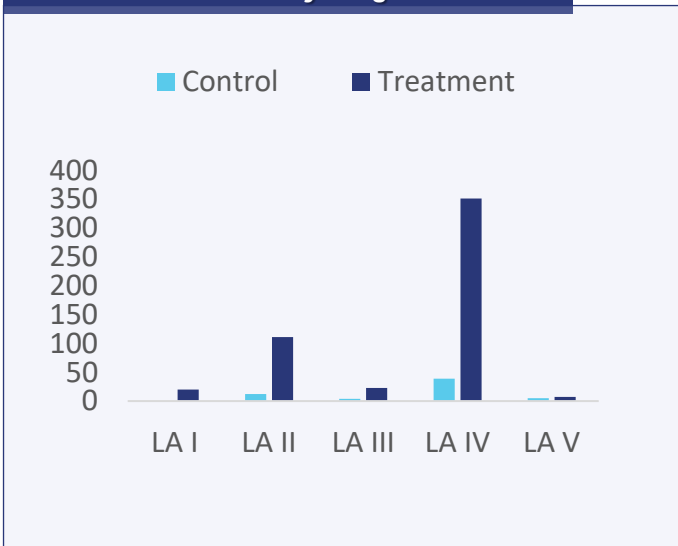
# RETAIN Program Evaluation

- For This Quasi-Experimental Evaluation of RETAIN we will compare the Treatment and Control Groups and determine the effectiveness of RETAIN and its services

## The Program Evaluation Objectives Were to:

1.	Evaluate performance and identify best practices across local areas
2.	Make recommendations for continuous improvement for RETAIN
3.	Ensure that all participants meet eligibility requirements
4.	Determine how successfully RETAIN serves workers that are ill or injured

## Key Findings of the Program Evaluation

### Eligibility Requirements

- All participants meet the eligibility requirements

### Performance Details

- Average time period of a participant in the program is 29 days
- All Local Areas meet expectations for services and employment

### Serving Workers that are ill or injured

- Based on the data retrieved during the period analyzed, RETAIN program data is limited on determination of certain aspects of program evaluation
- The RETAINWORKS program exceeds expectations with regard to priority of service for workers that are ill or injured

### Recommendations for Continuous Improvement

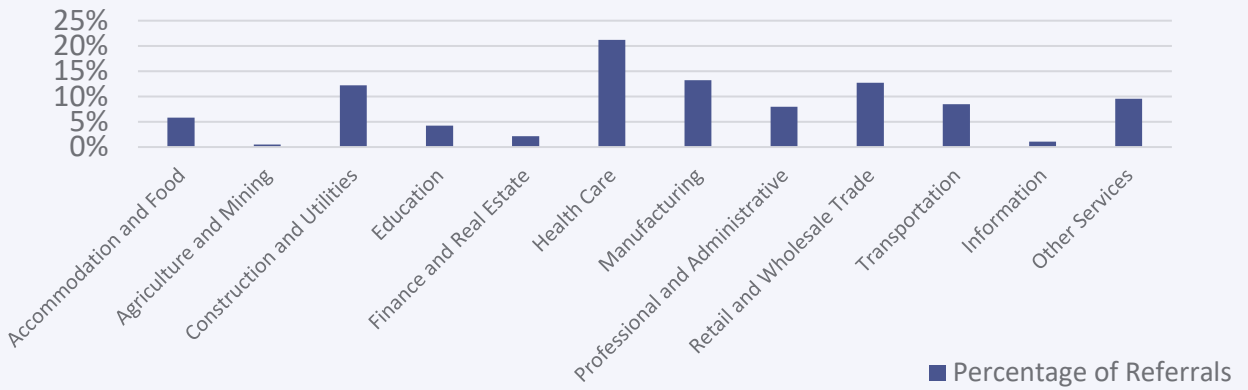
- Focus on the best practices across Local Areas

## Most Helpful Services by Local Areas



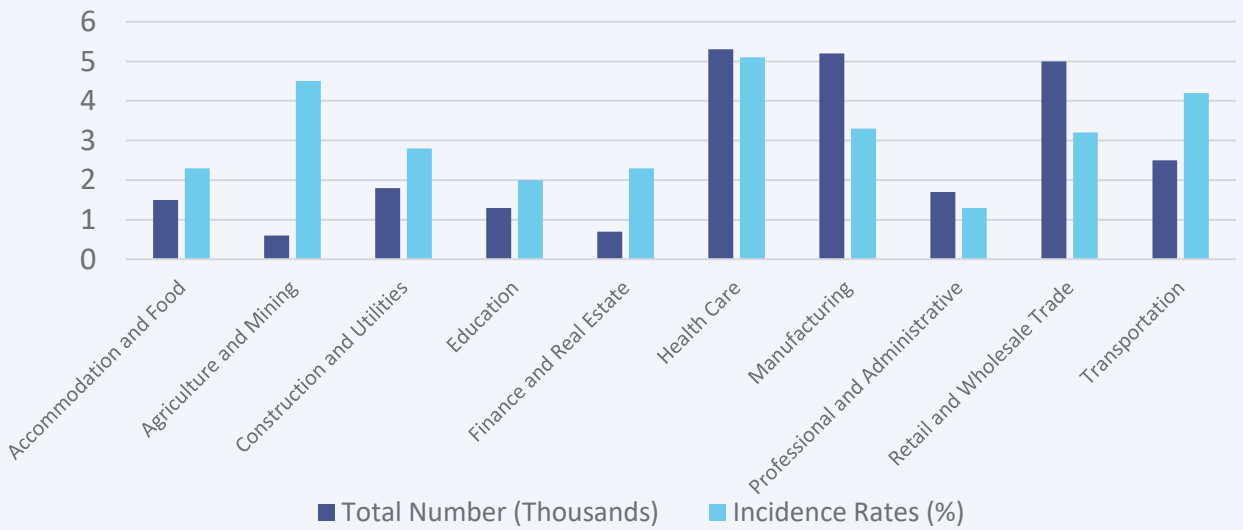
