The Program Evaluation Objectives Were to:

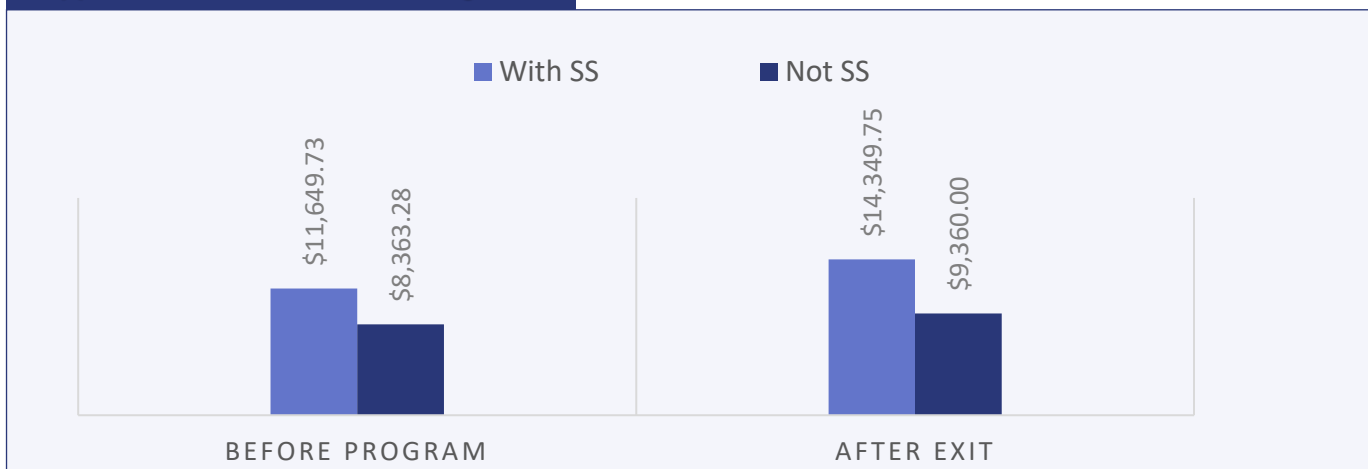
1.	Evaluate performance and identify best practices across local areas.
2.	Determine the effects supportive services have on outcomes for the Dislocated Worker program.
3.	Determine the outcome effects from receiving training through the Dislocated Worker program.

Key Findings of the Program Evaluation – Supportive Services

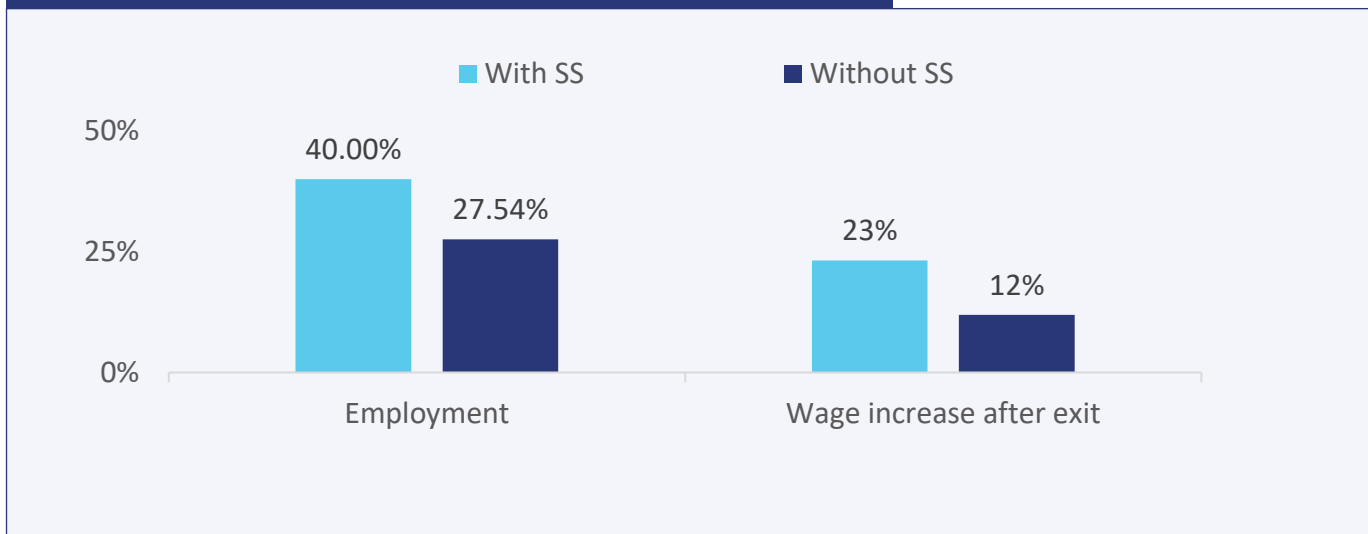
Performance Details

- Supportive Services had a positive effect on wages when comparing participants who received Supportive Services to participants who did not receive Supportive Services.
- Participants who received Supportive Services were more likely to attain employment after exiting the Dislocated Worker program than participants who did not receive Supportive Services.

Supportive Services Effect on Employment and Wage Increase

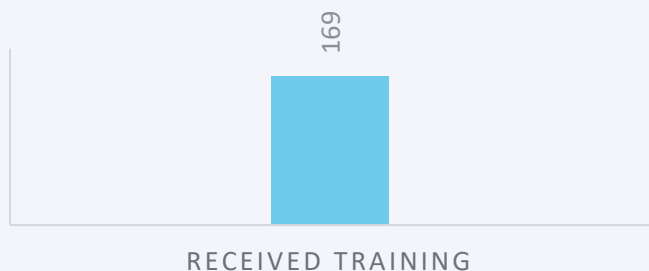


Dislocated Worker Program Evaluation

■ Average Number of Days



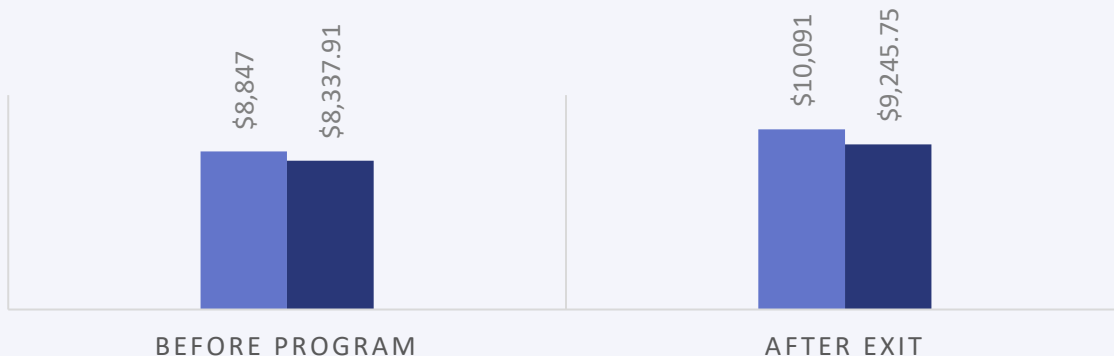
Key Findings of the Program Evaluation - Training

Performance Details

- The average time period for Dislocated Worker program participants receiving training was 169 days.
- Training through the Dislocated Worker program had a very positive effect on wages when comparing participants who received training to participants who did not receive training.
- Participants who receive training through the Dislocated Worker program were more likely to attain employment after exit than participants who did not receive training.
